



The track represents an ingress in the spectacular Dragasani vineyard, the oldest vineyard in the south of Romania, dating back to our dacian ancestors. The tourist is invited to taste and enjoy the multi-awarded wines of the vineyard at the wine cellars situated on the hills of Dragasani and to fire their imagination while listening to the local legends. Prince Stirbey –Cramposie Selectionata is a unique Romanian wine, which was presented for the first time in Germany at the International Wine Fair ProWein in Düsseldorf, in 2004. At present Cramposia de Dragasani sells best in Austria and France and Tamaioasa romaneasca de Dragasani is the best sold wine of the vineyard in France.

Those wanting to find out the story of the Dragasani wines can do this by visiting the Wine Museum, founded in 1974 and located in the town centre. The hills of the Dragasani vineyard are similar to those in Tuscany, this being the reason why not only white wines but also red wines are produced here.

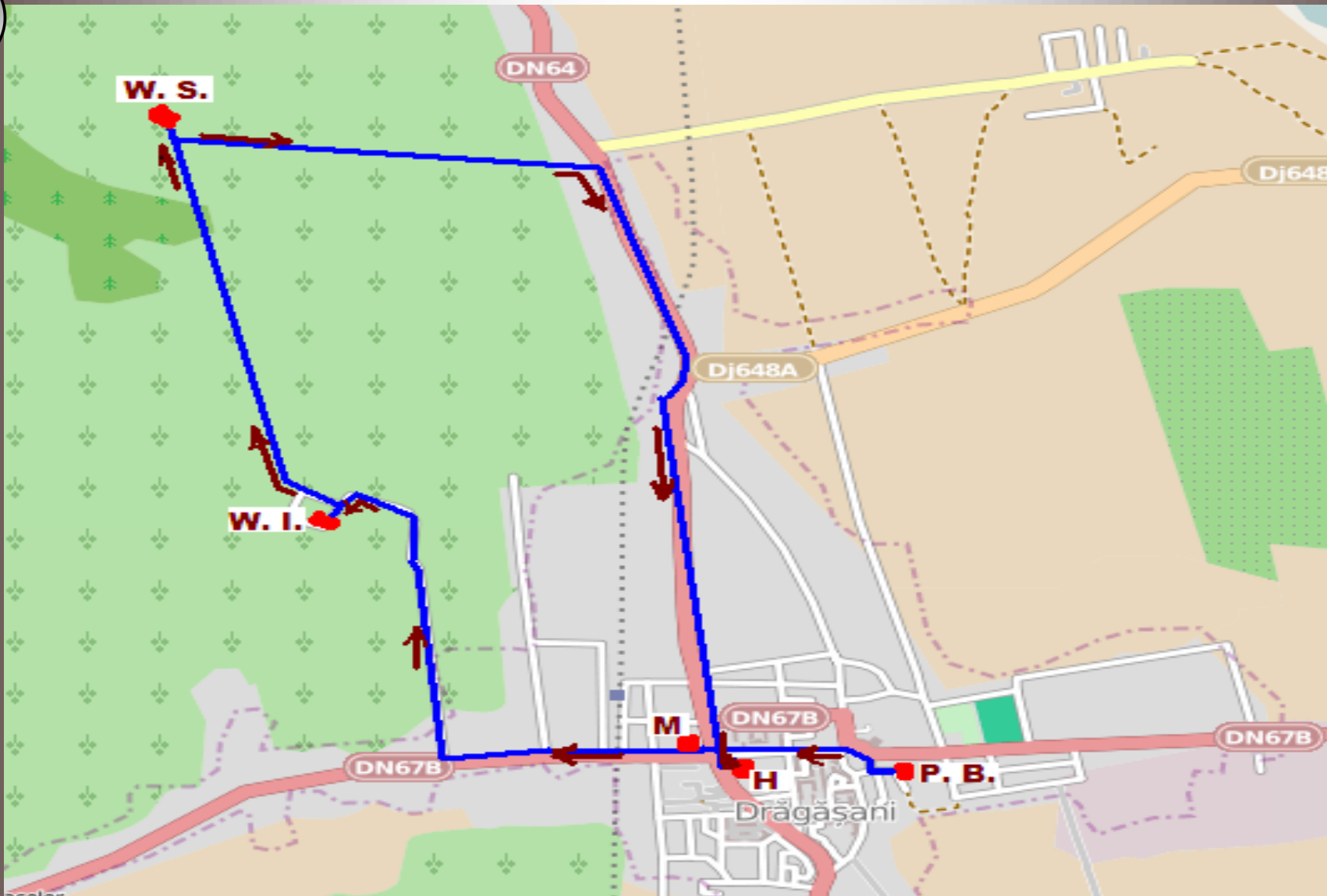


# Dragasani Legendary Wine Path
