Thank you for maintaining this incredible dataset, I'm an OpenStreetMap (OSM) contributor (an open data project similar to Wikipedia, but a map), and I was wondering what licence the data is under?

The main reason I'd like to use this data for OSM is to validate the marked pubs in OSM. With permission to use this data, we could find closed pubs that haven't yet been removed from OSM, making it easier to find the remaining pubs.

As OpenStreetMap is published under an open data licence (<u>ODbL 1.0</u>), we require written permission to use any data which is not public domain. Would you be able to provide a written waiver for the map's use in updating OSM?
